SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Burlington Christian Academy (BCA) is conveniently located in Burlington, between Greensboro and Durham, North Carolina. BCA is currently in its thirty-third year in existence and is the largest non-public school in Alamance County with almost 700 students enrolled from six different counties and international students from three countries. BCA has students from every socio-economic background and our school is located near historic downtown. In 2007, BCA completed a new gymnasium and activities center and has plans for a state of the art high school building. Our growth is directly linked to serving our community and its needs.

BCA has enjoyed a long standing reputation of providing students with an excellent, rigorous academic education within the context of a Christian worldview. Recognized as a school within the top 10% of all schools in the nation, BCA students score significantly above grade level on the *Stanford Achievement Test*.

In the fall of 2006 the BCA High school was established with a small freshmen class of 21 students. Our high school is now in the sixth year with an enrollment of 135 students in 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades. The class of 2010 was the first graduating class from Burlington Christian Academy's newly established high school.
